

**BIG CIRCUIT GAMES FOR 4th-5th.**

The Cuban Stars, who have just completed a swing around the circuit, will tackle the American Giants in Chicago, at Scherling Park, Sunday, July 4th; following them comes the K. C. Monarchs, who will romp with the Giants for honors, July 5, 6, 7, 8, 9. The K. C.'s have a collection of new players and they have boosted the chances of the far-West crowd considerably, that is, judging from the way the Westerners have been labbing wins here of late.

The Cubans go to St. Louis for the 7th, remaining for games 8, 7, 8, 9. The other traveling team, the Chicago Giants, go to Omaha, Neb., and will show in that city, 2, 4, 5.

The Dayton Marcos go to Detroit and will play the Wend A. A. Club on the 4th at Mack Park, in the absence of the Detroit Stars; they also play on the 7th, and will tackle the tough Cowpern All Stars. The Detroit Stars will try conclusions at Indianapolis with Taylor's

A. R. C.'s starting on the 11th and going again on the 5th.

The teams so far appear to be about divided in playing material and the results of the past few weeks does not reveal information that would give any one team any great amount of edge as to real ability over any specified opponent in the circuit; although the American Gladiators have tabbed up a long string of consecutive wins, results of the past week or so brings out the fact that while the Foster crew are formidable, they, like all the others, must take a bow now and then to all or each club of the circuit.
