

STORZ DIVIDE DOUBLE BILL

Leland Giants Cop First Combat,
but Lose the Second.

SANDERS WINS THE VICTORY

New Storz Twirler Holds Crack
Negro Team to Five Scattered
Hits and Wins Second
Battle.

The Leland Giants of Chicago, reputed as one of the star negro teams of the country, made their appearance at Rourke park Sunday, dividing a double bill with the Storz. The results of the bargain attraction were 11 to 4 in the visitors' favor in the first conflict, while the Storz copped the second contest by a 7 to 2 final.
